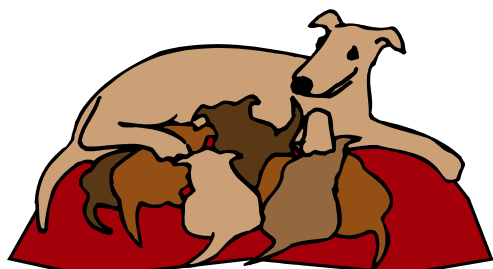
Just a reminder that all general meetings start at 7:15 p.m. on the third Tuesday of each month except July which is when we have our banquet.

Marion-Alachua Dog Training Association Board of Directors Meeting – April 5, 2011

The Meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM by President Compton. Attendees: Regina Compton, Sue Ann Bailey, Donna Hamm, Jean Murphy, Bob DuMond, Barbara Copping, Nellie Walter and Darcy Barnes.

Carol Harrison was absent.

APPROVAL OF BOARD OF DIRECTOR MINUTES for March 1, 2011 and Special Board Minutes of March 7.

Minutes of 3/1 were approved with corrections to the amounts for the Yard Sale and Silent Auction. Minutes of March 7 were approved as corrected with the Item 3 being revised to Pre-registration payment through the web site utilizing pay pal.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

--Regina reported the insurance premium of \$1600 was paid, but because the equipment valuation was estimated at \$29,000 for replacement costs, there will be a refund due. Last year the insurance coverage was for \$4,000 for equipment and minimal coverage on classes and the premium was \$580. This year the club is appropriately insured with a corresponding increase in the premium of about \$1,200. We bonded the President and Secretary as well.

TREASURER'S REPORT: -- No Report.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: -- No Report.

TRIAL AND COMMITTEE REPORTS:

--**AKC Obedience/Rally Trial:** All is on track for next year.

--**AKC Agility Trial:** Donna stated items that will be brought to the trial committee for consideration for next year will be the possibility of finding dates for a second trial or possibly adding events on Friday. Additions on Friday might be offering Excellent Only and a Time To Beat class. Recommendations from the committee will be submitted to the board.

--**UKC Obedience/Rally/Agility Trial:** Nellie reported that baskets were prepared by Susan Trotto and will be available for raffle both days. Members do not need to be present to win. Nellie also advised that Darcy was coordinating food vending to benefit 4H.

--**UKC Conformation Trial:** Dates for the conformation trial will be September 24/25 in the yellow building. The MADTA training building will be used for grooming and will be thoroughly cleaned upon completion. It will be an all breed trial including altered. Belgium Shepherd Dogs are excluded due to special licensing for this breed. There will be 4 judges. They will need volunteers to assist. Diane Fowler will teach the volunteers how to steward the conformation rings. The biggest initial expense is ribbons. They are looking at an outdoor trial in the Spring of 2012. They will be offering puppy classes (3 to 6 months) and Nellie is looking for judges for those classes. Puppy judges do not have to have credentials. Regina suggested that Nellie contact Janet Barber and/or Melanie Magamoll as they would be excellent choices to work with puppies.

--Training Committee:

----Jean announced that they will be offering a Novice Obedience and Rally Seminar on November 27.

Moderators will be Sally Hensen and Sharon Simon. This will be similar to the clinic held in 2008 and presented from the judge's point of view. It will be open to 10 working spots and unlimited auditing. It will be open to members and non-members as well.

MOTION by Barbara Copping, seconded by Nellie Walter, "To approve the November 27 Novice Obedience / Rally Seminar." **MOTION** carried unanimously.

----Jean announced there will be a CGC exam offered on June 27, and another one on Tuesday, May 17 to be held at 5 PM and be concluded by 7PM just before the start of the General Membership Meeting. Nellie Walter has agreed to be the evaluator and the cost is \$15 per dog.

MOTION by Nellie Walters, seconded by Barbara Copping, "To approve the CGC exam on May 17."

MOTION carried unanimously.

Jean announced that Karen Van Gunst has passed the CGC ribbons to her.

----Show N Go on April 2 generated \$701.50 dollars for the DACOF team.

--**Membership Committee:** Donna stated she had been contacted by Mary Ann Fitch and Mary Ann has the Outlook Program which will make maintaining the membership list easier. Due to time constraints Donna has not been able to meet with Mary Ann to teach her how to use the program. Donna hoped to be able to help Mary Ann with the membership list before the end of April.

Regina advised the board that the membership chair requirements were shared with Mary Ann Fitch and she has indicated she will be able to accomplish all the tasks. Carol Harrison will still send cards and flowers to members as she has done recently.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

--Membership Requirements and Dues Committee:

The committee consisted of Sharon Simon, Committee Chair, Regina Compton, Carol Harrison, Darcy Barnes, Judy DuMond, Susan Trotto and Lee Saputo.

The Board thought the committee had done a very thoughtful job on identifying membership requirements and looking at the dues structure.

Regina identified several concerns with expenses that she felt warranted an increase in the dues: She identified increases in insurance, phone and PO box expenses, maintenance and upgrade expenses for equipment and creating a larger bank reserve for the club to utilize in the event a different training location was required. She expressed the concern with MADTA's month to month lease arrangement with the county that there are no guarantees that our current facility will continue to be available. MADTA needed to increase reserves to accommodate that contingency.

MOTION by Jean Murphy, seconded by Barbara Copping, "To request Sharon Simon present the Membership requirements and dues increases at the April 15 General Membership meeting."

Donna had concerns about the required attendance provision in the committee recommendation. She felt the requirement for meeting attendance for application presentation and first and second readings was

exclusionary. There are people that cannot attend meetings on Tuesday evenings that would be good members, but this provision excludes them. Nellie agreed and gave the example of a friend that is an over-the-road truck driver that can't attend meetings, but has volunteered to help on multiple occasions and yet cannot be a member. Bob and Regina were in favor of the attendance requirement as they felt if the applicant can't attend meetings they likely will not volunteer. There was a lot of discussion on this item with the Board generally divided. Darcy offered a compromise and suggested amending the requirement to read that the applicant or their sponsor must attend the first and second reading.

There was also discussion on the number of times an applicant must attend meetings. The current recommendation could require attendance at 4 meetings. The board was in agreement that if the application is complete with sponsorship and payment that it could be presented for first reading upon receipt.

Jean and Barbara amended their motion as follows: **AMENDED MOTION** by Jean Murphy, seconded by Barbara Copping, "'To request that Sharon Simon present the membership requirements and dues increases at the April General Meeting and that the meeting attendance requirement be changed to 'the applicant or their sponsor must attend the general membership meeting at which the completed application is presented for first and second reading'." **Amended Motion** passed unanimously

----Class Fees / Rewards Program Committee – Nellie Walter

Nellie reported the committee members were: Sally Hensen, Margaret Douglas, Susan Trotto, Sally Shaw, Michelle Holmes, Pamela Primus, Sharon Starke. Nellie stated she would provide the full report of the committee at the next board meeting, her recollection of the recommendation is:

Non-Members - \$80

Members - \$70 with an additional \$10 discount for a second dog in the same class or a second class in the same session.

Non-member guide dog handlers will be able to attend first two obedience classes with a \$10 discount.

There was discussion on this item as well. Most board members were not willing to implement a class fee structure change until a Rewards Program is development and implemented. It is important to reward volunteers for their efforts with discount opportunities.

MOTION by Jean Murphy, seconded by Nellie Walter, "To ask Sue Ann Bailey to chair a committee to develop a rewards program. The committee should consist of at least 5 members." **MOTION** carried by a vote of 6 in favor and Sue Ann abstaining.

----Awards Committee – Sue Ann Bailey

Sue Ann stated the straw poll at the last meeting indicated the awards this year would be in the form of certificates. Regina stated she would work on the Awards form so it can be distributed to the members.

The Board still needs to hear from the committee regarding plaques.

--UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

----**Club Goals:** Due to the lateness of the hour, this item was deferred to the next meeting.

----**Waiver Forms.** A form was presented for review.

MOTION by Barbara Copping, seconded by Sue Ann Bailey, "To implement the Waiver Form with multiple lines to be signed by anyone utilizing the club facilities, other than classes as the class registration form has a waiver on it. The form will be used until filled and then a new form started. The form will have "MUST READ BEFORE SIGNING" in bold print added." **MOTION** carried unanimously.

----**Fans:** Due to the lateness of the hour, this item was deferred to the next meeting.

----**Instructor Seminar Benefits:** Due to the lateness of the hour, this item was deferred to the next meeting.

----**Gas Stipend for DACOF and DCOF Teams.** Due to the lateness of the hour, this item was deferred to the next meeting.

----**List of items for agility trial the club may need to purchase:** Due to the lateness of the hour, this item was deferred to the next meeting.

--NEW BUSINESS:

----**Schedule for cleaning mats:** Barbara says she cleans the mats once a month. She will have them cleaned prior to the UKC trial.

----**Lawn Mower:** Regina said it has come to her attention that the mower for the agility field is in disrepair and wanted to know if it should be fixed. The board agreed that as long as Dale Barber was willing to continue to mow the field that they would like to continue to utilize his services.

----**Agility for May/June Session:** Donna advised that due to thunderstorms becoming disruptive to regular classes during this time period, it's recommended that the final session be drop-in. Michelle Barnes has agreed to offer topics for each session rather than a 7 week class. There were no objections from the Board. There being no further business to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:40 PM.

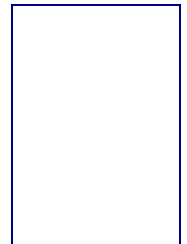
