TRIAL INFORMATION

NOTE: UKC limits judges to 200 entries/day. Entries will CLOSE when that Limit is reached.

Make checks payable to UMDTA. (Entry fees included UKC fee.)
Pre-entry Fee: \$18.00 first class, \$10.00 additional class for same dog, same trial on same day.
Early Entry Specials: One class per trial, 4 trials, same dog \$65.00; same dog/two classes per trial (8 runs) \$96.00; same dog/three classes per trial, \$110.00 – received by March 31, 2008.
Day of trial entry fee: \$20.00 first class, \$12.00 additional class for same dog, same trial, same day.
Day of trial entries will be taken 7:30 – 8:00 a.m. Exhibitors sending entries by overnight delivery must mark envelopes “No signatures required.”

Pursuant to UKC rules, dogs may enter both Agility I and Agility II, but the U-AGII title will not be awarded until the requirements for U-AG I are completed. Dogs must already have the U-ACH title to enter Agility III.

AG-I and AG-II are now divided, ‘A’ classes are for dogs that have not earned a title at that level. U-ACH points are only earned from the ‘B’ classes. Please include your dog’s UKC agility titles as part of your dog’s name on the entry form. This will assist the Trial Secretary in assuring that you are entered in the correct class.

MIXED BREEDS WELCOME

All dogs entered must be registered with the UKC.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial.

- Dogs up to 14 inches - - - - - Division 1 (8” jumps, 8” crawl)
- Dogs over 14 inches & up to 20 inches - Division 2 (14” jumps, 12” crawl)
- Dogs over 20 inches - - - - - Division 3 (20” jumps, 16” crawl)

BE SURE TO NOTE YOUR DOG’S HEIGHT ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.

BE SURE TO SPECIFY ‘A’ OR ‘B’ CLASS FOR AG-I AND AG-II. INCLUDE ALL UKC AGILITY TITLES WITH THE DOG’S NAME ON THE ENTRY FORM.

AWARDS

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers and placement ribbons (first through fourth places) will be awarded in each jump height division of each class.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Obstacles used will be listed in the UKC Agility Rules. Each dog entered in AG-IA and AG-IIA will be permitted to have course familiarization as allowed by the new UKC rules. A warm-up jump will be set-up by Trial ring.

These licensed agility trials will be conducted according to the agility rules of the United Kennel Club. All dogs must be registered with the UKC. Mixed breed dogs are eligible to enter BUT must be registered with the UKC.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or the trial is cancelled because of storms, hurricanes or conditions injurious to exhibitors and spectators. Entrees withdrawn prior to the trial will receive refunds less \$5 fee per day. A Plush Toy will be given to each dog entered & may be picked up at check in. We will have one Basket each day to be raffled off at end of the Trial(s) for that day. A 50/50 will also be offered each day.

UKC and United Marion Dog Training Assn. are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or un-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings the day of a UKC Event.

These trials will take place outdoors. Crating space is not limited. Exhibitors will need to provide their own lunches and drinks. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Overnight parking is at your own risk.

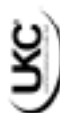

HOW TO USE THIS ENTRY FORM:

- All entries must be submitted on the current "Official UKC Entry Form". You may use one entry form to enter the same dog in more than one activity on the same weekend.
- Use a separate entry form for each dog entered in a club's event. 3. Dog not UKC registered! Apply for a Temporary Listing Number (TL) online at www.ukcdogs.com. TL numbers are valid for 60 days*. Fees are non-transferable and do not apply to the cost of permanent registration. *Call the Dog Events Department at (269) 343-9020 for current fee.
- Mail all completed entry forms to the Event Secretary listed under the event, unless otherwise specified. 5. Obedience Trials, Agility Trials, Weight Pull events and Dog Sport Trial events are open to all UKC recognized breeds and mixed-breed dogs with a valid Limited Privilege number.
- Obedience only: Check the box provided to request either the Veteran or Special Jump height option. Veteran dogs must be 8 years or older. Eligible dogs for Special Jump Heights are outlined in the current rules and regulations.
- Conformation classes consist of: Puppy (6 mos. under 1 yr.); Junior (1 yr. under 2 yrs.); Senior (2 yrs. under 3 yrs.); Adult (3 yrs. and up); Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family, Champion, and Grand Champion).
- Junior Showmanship classes consist of: Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)

We want you to keep the points earned at UKC Licensed events. Important things to remember.

- All dogs entering UKC events must be permanently registered, have a valid Temporary Listing Number, or a Limited Privilege number for performance events.
- All entry forms must be completed and signed. Incorrect information submitted on the entry form may invalidate your wins.
- To be eligible to enter into the Breeder/Handler class, you must be one of the breeders of record, or a member of the immediate family of one of the breeders of record. Immediate family includes: spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister.

WAIVER

All events are held under the Official Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.

Absolutely no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or firearms will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC Licensed event. UKC, its agents and employees, and the host club assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and the host club are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
